Genesis 12:3; Genesis 22:18	Decendent of Abraham through whom all nations would be blessed	Matthew 1:1; Acts 3:24-26	Son of Abraham; all families of the earth blessed
Numbers 9:12	His bones will not be broken	John 19:31-37	They did not break his legs
Psalms 16:10; Psalm 30:3	The Messiah would be resurrected	Matthew 28:5-7	He is not here, for he is risen
Psalms 22:7-8	Will be mocked and taunted	Matthew 27:39-40	the people walked by mocking him
Psalms 22:18	Garments will be divided by casting lots	John 19:23-24	They divided his clothing and cast lots for his tunic
Psalms 41:9	Betrayed by a friend	Luke 22:21-22; 22:47	Him who betrays me is with me; mob led by Judas
Psalms 91:10-12	Will be tempted by Satan	Matthew 4:5-7	Spent 40 days and nights in the desert and then the tempter came...
Isaiah 5-6, 8, 12	Wounded and crushed for our sins; Led Him away to His death	1 Peter 2:24	By His wounds you have been healed
Isaiah 7:14	He will be born of a virgin	Luke 1:26-27, 31	A virgin, Mary, will conceive
Isaiah 9:6	A child is born, ... and he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace	Luke 2:9-12	Angels said to shepherds unto you born... a Savior who is Christ the Lord
Isaiah 50:6	Will be beaten and spat upon	Mark 15:19	They beat him on the head and spit on him
Isaiah 53:3	Rejected by his own people	John 1:11-12	His own people did not receive him
Isaiah 53:5-6, 8, 12	Die as a sacrifice for our sins	1 Corinthians 15:3-4	Christ died for our sins
Isaiah 53:7	Silent before his accusers	Mark 15:5	Jesus made no reply
Isaiah 53:9	Buried in a rich man's tomb	Matthew 27:57-60	... a rich man laid it in his own new tomb
Isaiah 53:12	Crucified with thieves	Luke 23:32-33	They crucified two others, criminals
Jeremiah 23:5 (also 2 Samuel 7:12-16)	From the lineage of David	Luke 1:26-33	Joseph, of the house of David
Hosea 11:1	He would be called out of Egypt	Matthew 2:13-15	Flee to Egypt and remain there until I tell you
Micah 5:2	Born in Bethlehem	Matthew 2:1	... Jesus was born in Bethlehem
Zechariah 9:9	The Messiah would come riding on a donkey	John 12:15	And Jesus found a young donkey and sat on it
Zechariah 11:12-13	Betrayed for thirty pieces of silver	Matthew 26:14-15	Paid him thirty pieces of silver
Zechariah 12:10	Pierced	John 19:34	Pierced his side with a spear
Malachi 3:1 (also Isaiah 40:3)	Preceded by a messenger	Mark 1:2-4 (also Matthew 11:10)	John the Baptist
