INTRODUCTION

BIBLE VERSES

Genesis 13:14-17

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What dreams do you have for your life right now? What are you praying for your future? Your kids / grandkids future?
2. Read Genesis 13:15-16. This is God speaking to Abram. Notice how many times God says, “I will.” What are the things that have to happen that only God can do for your dreams to become reality?
3. What has been your response to those things? Are you trying to do those things that only God can do on your own, apart from Him? Have you given up on your dreams?
4. Where do you need to step out in faith and trust God with your dreams today?
5. In Genesis 13:14 God says to Abram, “Lift up your eyes and look from the place where you are...” In other words God is saying to Abram, “I want to show you *my* dream for what *could be* in your life if you’ll trust me.” What is God’s dream for you today?

MOVING FORWARD

As you think about what could be in your life, remember God’s dream for you requires looking beyond where you currently are. His dream for you requires His power. And His dream requires you to step out in faith.
