INTRODUCTION

If money talked and gave you its best advice, you might be surprised at what it would say. In this three-session study, Pastor Will teaches a biblical approach to money management that will help you understand how your money and your faith can work together.

BIBLE VERSES

Luke 16:1-12

Matthew 6:19-20

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. How was money handled in your house when you were growing up?
2. Pastor Will said that using money as a means to an end is what makes money meaningful. What do you think about that idea?
3. Who have you seen be a good example of leveraging their money to make their life meaningful? (You may or may not know them personally). Talk about what they did.
4. Read Luke 16:10-12. Pastor Will pointed out that Jesus is teaching us that we are managers, not owners...that God has given you a little time and a little creation to manage. If you viewed your money in this way, what would change?
5. To what ends do you want your life to be a means?
 - What do you want people to celebrate about you when you're gone?
 - What do you want people to line up and thank you for in the end?
6. How can you leverage more of what you have as a means to an end that's not you?

When you decide to be a means to an end, your money will follow.
