## **PART 2: MONEY TALKS: FLIPPING THE SCRIPT**

### **INTRODUCTION**

If money talked and gave you its best advice, you might be surprised at what it would say. In this three-session study, Pastor Will teaches a biblical approach to money management that will help you understand how your money and your faith can work together.

### **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

1. What would you do if you received an extra paycheck this month?
2. Pastor Will taught that most of the financial pressure you feel comes from how much you spend, not how much you make. Do you agree or disagree? Why?
3. Read Matthew 6:24. When are you the most tempted to allow money to be your master?
4. In our culture, “me-first living with some leftover giving” is the typical way to handle money. How is that similar to or different from what was modeled for you growing up?
5. Giving can either be reactive (i.e. giving to fundraiser after a natural disaster, chipping in when someone you know experiences hardship, or giving after being asked) or proactive (i.e. giving regularly to your church, sponsoring a child or missionary overseas). Which type of giving do you lean towards and why?
6. Pastor Will taught that “God-first living” starts with giving, then saving, then living on what’s left. Why do you feel a tension towards this type of living?
7. What is one step you can take this week to move towards “God-first” living with your money?

### **MOVING FORWARD**

Until Jesus is first in your finances, he’s not first in your life.

**Application Prayer:** Jesus, I commit to flip the script on the priorities for my money, because you first flipped your script for me. You are my Lord, my mastor, my Kyrios!
