INTRODUCTION

If money talked and gave you its best advice, you might be surprised at what it would say. In this three-session study, Pastor Will teaches a biblical approach to money management that will help you understand how your money and your faith can work together.

BIBLE VERSES

Matthew 25:14

2 Corinthians 9:6-8

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Which of the following best describes you as it relates to knowing where your money goes each month?
 - a. I avoid thinking about it
 - b. I'm generally aware of where it goes
 - c. I know exactly where every dollar goes
2. Read Matthew 25:14. What's your first reaction to the idea that you are managing money that God has entrusted to you? Does that match the way you've thought about money before now?
3. When we lose track of our money, we feel out of control and can even lose our peace of mind. Discuss a time when you felt out of control or distressed because of money. At that time, did you have a plan to track your spending?
4. Here's a challenge: For the next two months, document all your spending. Track where your money is going. Then...just look at it. Spend some time observing where your money has gone.
 - How does that challenge make you feel?
 - Do any tensions come up when you consider taking this challenge? What are they?
 - What adjustments would you guess need to be made after this challenge? Why?
5. Whether you are in a season where you have extra or not enough money, how can seeing God as the 100 percent owner of it all change your perspective? As a manager, what steps can you take toward being less fearful and more purposeful with your Master's money?
