INTRODUCTION

Are you ever confronted with circumstances that make you rethink or question parts of your faith? In all 4 of the conversations Jesus had with people after his resurrection he addressed some of the most common misconceptions we all face in our faith. Misconceptions are dangerous because we are making decisions for our lives (which will impact others) based on false-concepts, lies or deception. The Resurrection confronts humankind's greatest misconceptions about the Son of God. Join us as we look together at the 4 conversations Jesus has after his resurrection to clear away all misconceptions that get in the way of our faith.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Where have you felt unsettled in your life or your faith?
2. Pastor Will taught that there are 3 foundational, undeniable pillars that confirm the resurrection of Jesus: The empty tomb, the hundreds of eye-witnesses to the resurrected Jesus, and the inexplicable spread of Christianity during the first century. How do these pillars strengthen your faith in Jesus?
3. Read Acts 9:1-20. These events happened over 3 days. What changed over the course of these 3 days to take Paul from a place of "breathing murderous threats against the Lord's disciples" to boldly preaching "Jesus is the Son of God?"
4. Pastor Will taught that when Paul grasped the resurrection, it forced him to reread the entire Bible with a Christ-centered framework. How can you read the Bible with a Christ-centered framework? (A great resource to help with this is [The Gospel Transformation Bible](#) published by Crossway)
5. What objections or doubts do you (or others you know) have to Christianity? Do any of these things mean that Jesus could not have risen from the dead?
6. If you believed beyond any doubt that Jesus resurrected from the dead, how would it (or how does it) change the way you live every part of your life today? What keeps you from giving God your "Yes" today?

Application Prayer: Jesus, in light of your resurrection: What would you have me do, Lord? I give you my "Yes."
