DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Pastor Will pointed out that even most of the people God used in the Bible constantly struggled with personal doubt. Gideon claimed that he was insignificant (Judges 6:15) and Moses felt inadequate (Exodus 4:10). What personal doubts do you struggle with?
2. Have you found yourself trying to overcompensate for your insecurities? Describe a time when you lived FOR the approval of people instead of living FROM the approval of God. What's the difference between the two?
3. In the movie, the record producer asked Johnny Cash, "What's your one song?" What's your one song? Who are you called to be?
4. Read 1 Peter 5:8. Pastor Will taught that when you start to know who you are in Christ your spiritual enemy will do everything possible to convince you to believe something different. When and how have you felt the temptation to believe a lie about who you are?
5. What specific things can you do to "stay alert" and to "watch out for your great enemy, the devil?"
6. Read Psalm 34:17-18. What do you need to cry out to God for help for today?
