- 5. Who can you surround yourself with that will help you grow?
- 6. When is it most difficult for you to have a good attitude at work? How can you remind yourself in those moments that as a follower of Jesus, you ultimately are working for an audience of one?
- 7. Read 2 Kings 4:1-7 and John 6:9-13. What little thing do you have, or what little thing can you start tomorrow that could make a big thing happen? What is your role when it comes to that little thing? What is God's role? What is keeping you from trusting God with that little thing right now?
