- 2. Read Mark 10:41-45 aloud. Why do you think the other ten disciples were upset?
- 3. Define "greatness" as it relates to the world.
- 4. In Mark 10:43 Jesus says four words that change everything for his followers: "Not so with you." How does Jesus redefine what it means to be "great"?
- 5. Which of these better describes you: "Believer in Jesus" or "Follower of Jesus"? Why do you say that?
- 6. What would it really mean for you to follow the way of the cross? In terms of giving away your life for the sake of someone else's well being, what's your next step? Do any of the following words give you an idea?
