


CREATING A “FLIGHT PLAN” FOR YOUR GROUP

TAKEOFF—FIRST 90 DAYS

- Stay connected to God.
- Focus on relationships.
- Make sure everyone has each other’s contact information.
- Plan regular socials.
- Schedule times to meet one-on-one with each group member or couple.
- Share tasks with your group members:
 - Hosting meetings
 - Bringing snacks
 - Sending texts/emails to group members
 - Planning socials
 - Planning service projects
- Decide what you’ll study when you finish *Circle Up*.
 - Get to know your group members.
 - What kind of study will help them take next steps?
 - Focus on studies that include application-based discussion questions.

 - Planning socials
 - Planning service projects
- Plan a service project together.
- Cast vision that the long-term goal of the group is to multiply.



FLIGHT—THE MIDDLE MONTHS

- Stay connected to God.
- Continue to focus on relationships.
- Name and celebrate growth in group members.
- Decide together who and how you'll serve on a regular basis (monthly, quarterly, or three times a year).
- Start talking about the end of the group.
- Identify potential future leaders, invite them into leadership, and begin sharing responsibilities:
 - Facilitating group discussions
 - Connecting one-on-one with group members
 - Helping select group studies
 - Attending leadership development opportunities

LANDING—THE LAST 90 DAYS

- Stay connected to God.
- Continue to focus on relationships.
- Keep having conversations about group multiplication.
- Create a plan for multiplication:
 - Consider relational chemistry and stage of life when making decisions about how the group will multiply.
 - Involve everyone in the decision-making.
 - Be open and transparent.
 - Be creative, consider lots of options, and choose the option that will work best for your group AND create more space for other adults in groups.
