DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. Describe a time and place that you felt like an "outsider." Did somebody come along and invite you in or welcome you? What difference did that make? What do you wish somebody had done for you in that circumstance?
- 2. Read Luke 19:1-6. Zaccaeus was an outsider. But Jesus saw and loved him right where he was. Have you ever felt like you had to change something about yourself before God could possibly see you, care about you, or love you?
- 3. Pastor Will said, "If you have been invited into God's family, you have the gift of being able to invite other people into His family too!" Who do you know right now that might be feeling alone, like an outsider? How can you share the acceptance and love of Jesus with that person?
- 4. Has your experience of being loved and treasured by God made space in you to forgive someone who has hurt you?
- 5. Read Luke 19:10. Why did Jesus come? How can you join Him in His mission?
- 6. What is your next step in partnering with Brazos Fellowship as we pursue the mission of Jesus to make disciples? Lead a small group? Serve? Invite somebody to church?
