KEY SCRIPTURE

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. When you pray, do you tend to ask God to do whatever you tell Him, or do you surrender yourself to Him and commit to do whatever He tells you to do?
2. What area of your life do you feel like there's no hope? What would you like God to do in that area, even if it took a miracle?
3. The sign, or miracle, in John 2 came after some hard work (see John 2:6-7). What if Jesus is saying to you today: "I'm going to do a miracle in this area of your life that you thought there's no hope—but you're going to have to let go of your anger, forgive, become more selfless than you've ever been? What is the hard work that you may need to do?"
4. Pastor Will said, "Wherever you are not enough: Jesus is Messiah!" Where do you feel like you're not enough? What would believing that Jesus is enough change for you?
5. God uses marriage throughout the Bible to describe His relationship to His people—He is the bridegroom and His people are the bride. What does the bride look like in the eyes of the groom at a wedding?
6. What would be different about your life if you lived every moment as if it were true that God adores you and He's given His life for you?
7. What is Jesus telling you to do today?

Application Prayer: Jesus, I will obey whatever you tell me to do. I bring you my emptiness and disappointment. I look to you to meet my deepest needs.
